Oshawa Public Libraries to Begin Offering Computer Appointments June 7, 2021

Oshawa Public Libraries, May 27, 2021

Starting June 7, all Oshawa Public Libraries branches will begin offering computer appointments and access to printing and photocopying services in addition to its current Library take-out services. In-person browsing and study and leisure spaces remain unavailable at this time. Additional access to the Library's spaces and services will be restored in stages according to the Province's Re-opening Plan. As access and services continue to evolve and may vary between different Library locations, we encourage people to visit the Library's website for the most up-to-date information.

Physical distancing, proper hand hygiene, and wearing a non-medical face mask or face covering are required while in the Library. The Library continues with increased cleaning practices of high-touch items and surfaces for our shared health and safety. Anyone experiencing COVID-19 symptoms must postpone their library visit and call Telehealth or their health care provider for assessment.
